# **H1N1 and Seasonal FLU VACCINE**

**Naval Branch Health Clinic-Groton**

**Seasonal Flu Vaccine** *for all beneficiaries* is available  
and

Very **limited** quantities of the **H1N1 Flu Vaccine** is available for **Tricare Prime Enrollees** of Naval Branch Health Clinic Groton meeting the priority populations below.

**Influenza A H1N1 (nasal spray/injectable) vaccine is restricted for the following priority populations:**

- § **Pregnant women**
- § **Persons aged 6 months through 24 years**
- § **Persons who live with or provide care for infants aged <6 months (e.g., parents, siblings, and daycare providers)**
- § **Persons aged 25–64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications\***

*If you recently received the flumist vaccine for **seasonal influenza**, you **must wait 28 days** before receiving the nasal spray vaccine for H1N1 influenza. There is no recommended minimum waiting period between the injectable seasonal and H1N1 vaccines; shots can be given simultaneously.*
