8. POST 9/11 GI BILL REMINDER - DEADLINE APPROACHING. Sailors considering Post-9/11 GI Bill Benefit transferability and who have children approaching college age, about to start higher learning or a spouse with college aspirations, now is the time to ensure action is taken to ensure their transferability is properly set up. Qualified active duty Sailors may elect to transfer benefits to a spouse or children, with some or all benefits allocated to those named on the transferability application. There are currently many Sailors whose transferability requests are being rejected (25% of all submissions) because they do not have four years of obligated service remaining. For enlisted personnel that means having sufficient obligated service prior to their end of active obligated service. For officers, it means having an administrative remarks entry (Page 13) in their electronic service record (ESR) agreeing to serve four more years from the date their transferability request is submitted.

The Navy announced the transferability process in NAVADMIN 203/09 which requires TWO additional years for Sailors eligible for retirement between 1 August 2010 and 31 July 2011, or THREE additional years for those with 20 years service between 1 August 2011 and 31 July 2012. Otherwise, Sailors must have served at least SIX years and agree to an additional FOUR years. After obligating service, Sailors must elect the transferability option while still serving. Note that Sailors can allocate any percentage of their benefit to their spouse and children; can change it any time, but if they DO NOT elect the benefit while serving, they WILL NOT be able to go back and do it. Additionally, family members must be entered in DEERS and be eligible for benefits in DEERS before a Sailor can request transferability. This means dual-military members whose children are reflecting under only one sponsor's record, must be documented in DEERS under both sponsors. To establish a child as a family member under both military parents, the child should be enrolled in DEERS under one parent for benefits and under the other parent as a child drawing benefits from another military sponsor.

Sailors should be reminded that spouses can use the benefit immediately, but children can not use the benefit until the Sailor has served the FULL four year obligation. So the sooner transferability is requested, the sooner the four year obligation begins. Refer to the NAVADMIN for exceptions.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Before submitting a transferability request, the Sailor must verify that their obligation requirement is reflected in their ESR. If it is not, the request will be rejected!.

9. DOD MILITARY SPOUSE PROGRAM RESTORED. The Department of Defense announced 20 July 20 the resumption of a restructured military spouse career advancement account program - MyCAA, following a comprehensive review. The program will be available to spouses of service members in the pay grades of E1-E5, W1-W2 and O1-O2 beginning 25 October 2010. The changes reflect a return to the original intent of the program to help military spouses with the greatest need to successfully enter, navigate and advance in portable careers. Changes to the program include: Eligible spouses will receive a total of \$4,000 in DoD-funded financial aid, with an annual cap of \$2,000 per fiscal year; funding must be used within a three-year period from the start date of the first class; and must be used to obtain an associates' degree, licensure or certification.
