1. Census. Forms will be mailed out 1 March for everyone to complete. Sailors that live in the permanent party barracks will have their forms delivered to their door on 1 April by the CBQ staff. There will be a Census Representative in Shepherd of the Sea from 22 March to 1 April on Monday, Wednesday and Thursdays from 0900 - 1400 to answer any questions.

2. ID Card Services. PSD New London has transitioned ID card services to a contracted service provider. The location of the ID Card Laboratory will remain the same on SUBASE New London; Building 83, Room B10. However, the new hours of operation are as follows:

Monday through Friday: 0730-1600. Customers will be allowed to enter the ID card laboratory until 1530.

On the first Saturday of each month, to provide Reserve Personnel support, the ID Card Laboratory will be open from 0900-1200. Customers will be allowed to enter the ID Card Laboratory until 1130. If the first Saturday of a particular month falls on a holiday, the ID Card Laboratory will be opened on the second Saturday of that month and the same hours will apply.

It is important to note that CAC cards take 15-20 minutes to prepare and dependent/retiree ID cards take 7-10 minutes to prepare. Per Contract

specifications, the ID Card Laboratory must be secured no later than 1600 and 1200 as applicable. Given the required preparation times for CAC and ID cards, and ID Card Laboratory schedule, customers must plan accordingly.

To ensure smooth processing, customers need to bring two valid identity source documents containing photographs. If only one document is a valid state or federal government issued picture ID, the other must be a social security card. The requirement for having two photo ID's does not apply to dependent children already in DEERS under the age of 20. (PERSUPP DET NEW LONDON CT DTG 221513ZFEB10)

3. Commissary Parking lot. Starting 15 March, a large section of the middle of the east side of the parking lot will be blocked off to allow a contractor to work in the steam trench that goes from bldg 433 to the site of the new commissary. This area will be secured for two weeks and after it is restored, work will then shift to the other side of the lot. (SUBASE DTG 082200ZMAR10)
